

Retiring the ATOS Temporary Revision process

The ATOS Broadcast message (BCM) will stand-alone for the inspector to view the DCT changes prior to the next DCT release without the need to review the same information in the ATOS Temporary Revisions.

References in Order 8900.10 (captured below) will be revised to instruct inspectors to review the ATOS BCMS for changes in the appropriate DCTs prior to beginning an assessment. Once the inspector acknowledges a BCM on the ATOS home page, the BCM may be accessed again by going to the FSIMS Publications tab and clicking on the ATOS BCM link. ATOS BCMS may also be available on the ATOS News and Documents page; however, they are only archived to the ATOS News and Documents page quarterly.
