SUBJECT: AUTHORIZATION OF ADVISORY CIRCULAR SYSTEM

1. PURPOSE. This order authorizes the continued use of the FAA Advisory Circular System.
2. DISTRIBUTION. This order is distributed to branch level in Washington, and to division level in regions and centers.
3. BACKGROUND. Order OA P 1320.2, FAA Advisory Circular System, issued August 9, 1962, is now obsolete and out-of-date. It initially set forth the responsibilities, procedures, and standards for the FAA Advisory Circular System. A new detailed order will be issued by the Director of Management Systems describing the FAA Advisory Circular System, listing the primary responsibilities of issuing offices, establishing standards for format, writing, and clearance procedures, and setting forth current instructions for copy preparation. When issued, the implementing order will cancel Order OA P 1320.2.
4. POLICY. The FAA Advisory Circular System, shall be utilized as the primary means for distributing material of a nonregulatory nature to the public.
5. ISSUANCE AUTHORITIES. Office and service heads are authorized to approve and issue advisory circulars in their respective areas of functional responsibility.
