Objective: Observe and evaluate the in-flight operations of the certificate holder within the total operational environment of the air transportation system. This includes assessment of elements both internal, e.g., crewmembers and flight conduct, and external, e.g., airport/heliport and ATC/airspace to a specific operator.
