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1 System Identification

The Safety Assurance System (SAS) is a tool used by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Office of Flight Standards (AFS) to conduct initial certification and surveillance for 14 CFR parts 121, 135, and 145. AFS developed SAS to enhance and standardize certification and oversight of certificates by incorporating system safety principles, safety attributes, and risk management.

3 Defects Resolved in This Release

The following defects reported to the SAS Help Desk have been fixed in this release. The table below lists these Help Desk issues and their associated software defects.

Note: There are two issues that were reported via the FAA inspectors that will impact External Users as well:

- In Vitals, the Accountable Manager email field was limited to 20 characters and will now be extended to 50 characters.
- In the Vitals Aircraft table, only the first MMS displayed, now, all rows will display.

The columns and their descriptions are as follows:

- **SAS Help Desk ID:** The ID of the SAS Help Desk ticket for the defect.
- **Issue:** A short description of the reported defect.
- **SAS Defect ID:** The ID of the software defect causing the issue.
- **Fix Applied:** A short description of how the defect was resolved.
- **FAA IT ID:** The reference number of the associated FAA Help Desk ticket, if applicable.
